



## Moodle quiz windows by group or user


1. Create a quiz and set a window to open as normal. In this example, the quiz is open 1/9/2012-1/10/2012

Open the quiz  9  January  2013  09  12  Enable

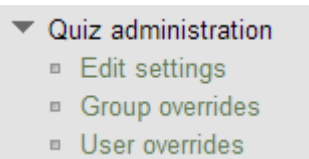
Close the quiz 10  January  2013  09  12  Enable

Time limit  0  minutes   Enable

When time expires  Attempts must be submitted before time expires, or they are not counted

Submission grace period  1  days  Enable

2. You do not need to select any group options in the quiz creation screen. Continue creating your quiz as usual, adding questions, etc.
3. Under the settings block, find Quiz administration>Group overrides or User overrides accordingly



4. Choose the option to add a group (or user) override.
5. On the next screen, choose the group for which you want to add an exception, input a password if desired, and set the options. This allows you to change the open window, time limit, and attempts allowed.
6. When complete, choose to save or save and add another. When you choose save, you will be presented with a list of overrides sorted by group or user.

7. Groups or users not listed under the overrides will get the default settings assigned when the quiz was created.
